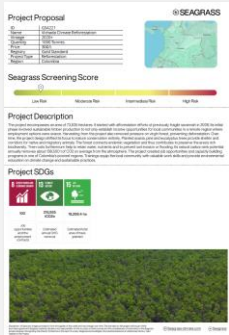

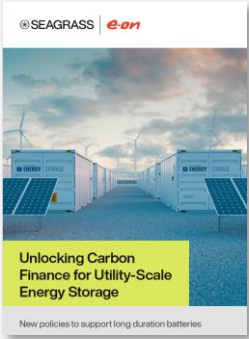
Leveraging Carbon: Sustainability & Corporate Strategy

Amidst evolving environmental attribution certificates, regulations and different business models, comes climate, cost and liability exposures, We support clients to understand how to leverage carbon markets for their sustainability and wider organisational goals.

Examples

E.ON UK

We're working with E.ON UK to develop carbon financing mechanisms to support energy storage and long-duration battery projects.



Fuel Switching

Together with a global verification body, we're developing frameworks that support financing for high-emitting fuels and phase out.



East Africa

Partnering with regional governments, we're supporting the market development of their voluntary and compliance schemes.



Carbon Financing

We're helping to deliver financing and capital into emission reduction and remove projects, with social impact.

Compliance Sector

Structuring Multi-stakeholder Jurisdictional Projects

There is an increasing demand of compliance certificates from the Public and Private sector. We're helping structure and deliver upfront financing to large-scale transactions which require funding, often with upfront concessional capital, and deliver relevant credits across the project lifecycle.

Examples

Financing Grids

We're supporting financing for the development of grid infrastructure in emerging markets.

Working with multi-lateral banks and investors, we're helping to close the gap on the 80 million Kms of grids that need to be added or replaced by 2040, with an annual investment of US\$820bn per annum, according to IEA.



Voluntary Sector

Structuring Carbon & Project Investment

We're structuring and facilitating investment into projects that sequester carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. Projects include Forestry, Soil and Water Management, Blue Carbon, Peatlands Restoration, CDRs, Bio-fuels, EV deployment and Fuel Efficiency improvement.

Example: Rwanda

With the Government of Rwanda, Seagrass is helping to deliver investment to a transmission line that connects a hydro power plant to the city of Kigali. The US\$45m project will deliver an estimated 380k+ CO2 emission reductions per year, taking a large proportion of diesel electricity generation offline, and availing Article 6 IMTOs credits to investors providing concessional capital.



Projects with Impact

Providing access to a balanced portfolio of projects

Reductions



Nature-based

Using natural ecosystems to reduce GHG emissions & boost carbon sequestration, addressing climate change with added environmental and socio-economic benefits. These projects include **Forest Protection and Improved Forest Management**.



Renewable Energy

Renewable energy projects reduce greenhouse gas emissions by generating clean energy from sources like **Wind, Solar, Hydro, and Geothermal** replacing fossil fuel-based energy.



Social Impact

A community-based carbon reduction project empowers local communities to implement sustainable practices that reduce GHG emissions and enhance environmental resilience such as **Cookstoves** and **Clean Drinking Water** projects.



Industrial

Industrial reduction projects focus on reducing carbon emissions in industrial settings through energy efficiency projects, process optimisation, and equipment upgrades, e.g., **ODS Recovery & Destruction, Orphaned & Abandoned Well Plugging, and CCS**.



Nature-based

These projects harness natural processes to remove & store CO2 from the atmosphere. Projects include: **Afforestation, Reforestation, Improved Forest Management, Blue Carbon, Grasslands, Biochar, and Regenerative Agriculture**.



Engineered CDR

Engineered solutions, designed to capture and store CO2, include **Direct Air Capture, Enhanced Rock Weathering, BECCS**. These technologies remove atmospheric carbon while supporting climate mitigation efforts.

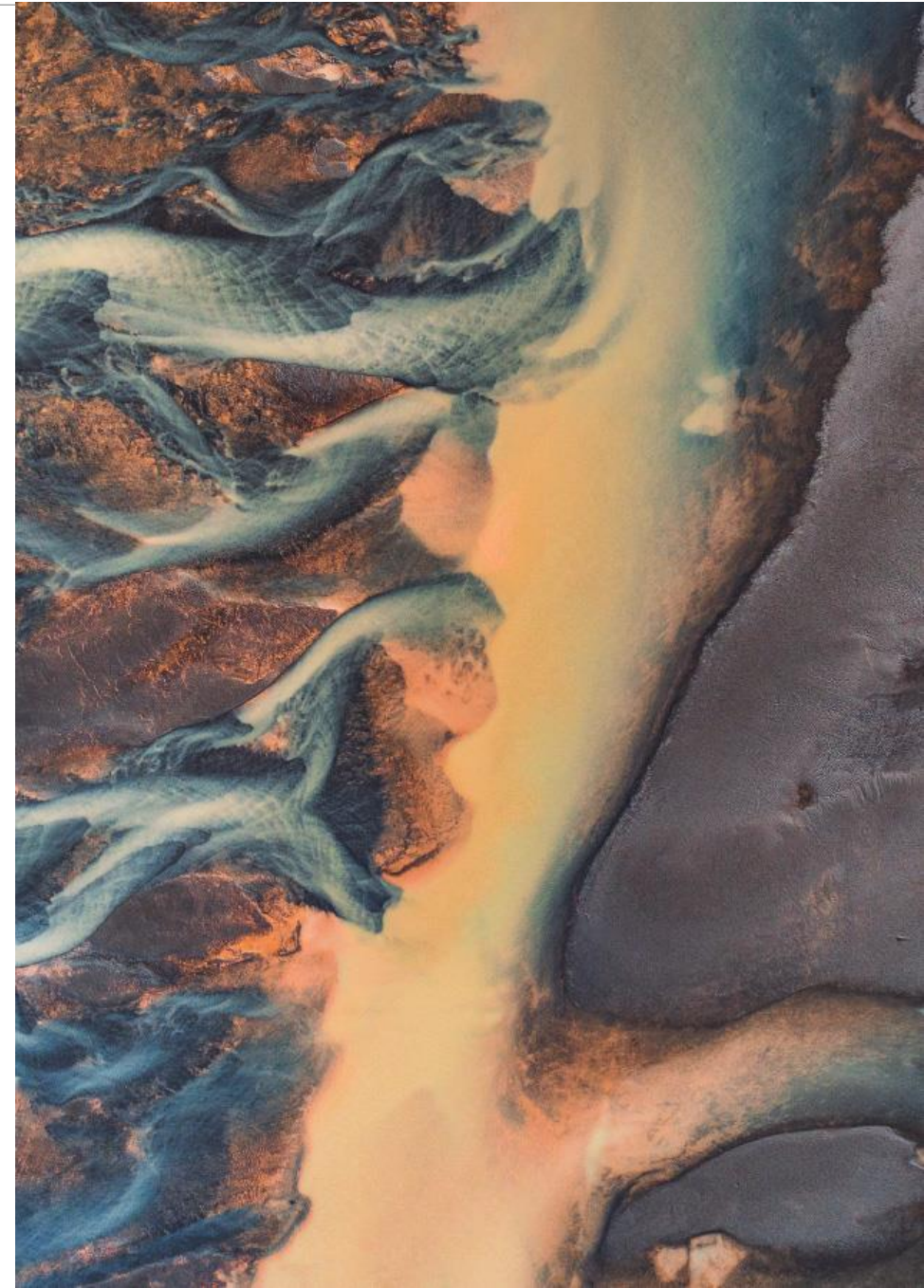
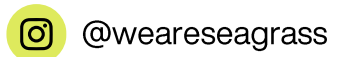
